The numbers are staggering. Only 19% of software developers are female, and only 5% overall are in tech leadership roles. While there are over one million tech jobs being created by U.S. corporations each year, there are not enough talented people to fill those openings even though there is an increased emphasis on Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM). With women and people of color not participating in or inventing technology, these pipeline challenges will persist and therefore affect the economy. *Necessary Inclusion: Embracing the Changing Faces of Technology* is the one book that not only breaks down the challenges into digestible bites, it also provides a road map to solving this ever-expanding problem.
